Register well in advance to facilitate the registration process. Every effort will be made to try to match your choice. If you wish to camp with / next to someone, register at the same time. Due to the increased number of attendees, we simply cannot guarantee that you will end up camping together.

- \_\_\_\_\_ **Jacobs Grove** (13 campsites available each with 1-4 tentsites)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **River Bend** (10 campsites available each with 2-5 tentsites)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Yakima** (20 campsites alongside river / 6 across access road from river, 2-6 tents/site)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Yakima Meadows** (20 acres of open meadow for more than 100 tents)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Beaver Lodge Island** (20 tentsites available)
- \_\_\_\_\_ I may need help setting up my tent.

**Note:** If you plan to bring children (mixed gender) then you should plan to bring your own tent, if at all possible.

### I WILL NOT BRING A TENT

If you do **not** bring a tent, the following shelters are available.

**You still need to bring a sleeping bag, air mattress and pillow.**

- \_\_\_\_\_ **Trillium Longhouse - Large** (5 longhouses, each sleeps 40) Reserved for the "30-something" group.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Trillium Longhouse - Small** (1 longhouse available, sleeps 20)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Trillium Wall Tent** (6 tents available. Each sleeps 8)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Lockomora Open A-Frame** (19 A-Frames available. Each sleeps 8)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Lockomora Wall Tent** (13 tents available. Each sleeps 8)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Ayatma Teepee** (18 teepees available. Each sleeps 8. Limited protection during rain.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Ayatma Wall Tent** (9 tents available. Each sleeps 8)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Beaver Lodge Island Teepee** (2 available. Each sleeps 8. Limited protection during rain.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Summer Cabin - Large** (2 available. Each sleeps 12)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Summer Cabin - Small** (3 available. Each sleeps 8)

### OTHER SLEEPING OPTIONS

The following accommodations are also available. Please choose bottom bunk only if you are physically unable to climb to the top bunk. Bring a sleeping bag and pillow for bunks and loft floor. Loft floor will need air mattress as well. Please do not choose these as your only 3 options unless you are unable to camp out in a tent, teepee, longhouse, or A-frame.

- \_\_\_\_\_ **Main Lodge - Bottom Bunk** (Limited available beds – for C/Pap machines)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Bunkhouse - Top Bunk** (3 units each divided into 2 sections with 5 top bunks per section, 30 bunks)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Bunkhouse - Bottom Bunk** (3 bunkhouses, 2 sections each with 5 bottom bunks per section, 30 bunks)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Family Cabin** (6 available. 1 queen bed, 1 set bunk bed, loft floor for 6)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **R.V. Site** (9 available with water, power and sewer)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **R.V Site** (12-14 self-contained, sites without water, power, sewer)

### Ensign Ranch 2010 SA Campout – What to Bring

Facilities at Ensign Ranch include many tent sites and a limited number of lodge rooms, bunkhouses, A-frames cabin tents, and shared cabins. All locations have access to potable water and toilet facilities. Showers are also available.

Established campsites usually have picnic tables and a small fire place; although **campfires will be prohibited** if there is a fire ban in effect which had occurred each of the last two years. Meadow and island campsites are not “*established*” and have no tables or fireplaces.

<b>Suggested Campout Provisions for All Campers</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Flashlight (spare batteries)</li> <li>• Sleeping Bag (or bedding- pad or air mattress too)</li> <li>• Clothes for: recreation, swimming, dances, church service, warm days / cool evenings, inclement conditions (we don't like to say the “R” word)</li> <li>• Towels, soap, toothbrush, razor, etc.</li> <li>• Cooler (for perishable foods)</li> <li>• Cook Stove (propane or gas)</li> </ul> <p><b>NOTE: If there may be a fire ban in effect this year, no campfires will be allowed. No charcoal allowed.</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cookware, serving dishes, and utensils</li> <li>• Bring your own water bottles / 5 gallon water jugs</li> <li>• Insect repellent</li> <li>• Band Aids - first aid kit</li> <li>• Medicine for duck itch / swimmer's itch</li> </ul> <p><b>Additional for Tent Campers</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tent (directions and ground cover - optional)</li> <li>• Table (for cooking etc.)</li> <li>• Camp stool or chair(s)</li> <li>• Air mattress or pad</li> <li>• Lantern (bring fuel, spare mantle, or batteries)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Some common needs (if you forget supplies, or need more):</b></p> <p><b><i>Cle Elum is about 7 miles to the East of Ensign Ranch (12 min. drive away)</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ice for coolers</li> <li>• Fuel: Propane tank refill, white gas, and propane bottles</li> <li>• Ice cream!</li> <li>• Groceries available at Safeway stores</li> <li>• Hardware and Sporting Goods are available at several stores</li> <li>• Several restaurants and fast food places</li> </ul>	<p><b>Recreational Supplies (optional)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Frisbee</li> <li>• Bicycle</li> <li>• Sports equipment</li> <li>• Fishing gear (State fishing license is required as well as a permit from the ranch)</li> <li>• Flashlights for walking and riding bikes in a tunnel (plus extra batteries)</li> <li>• Small rubber raft, canoe, kayaks, swim tube, etc. (life jackets)</li> <li>• Water socks required for slip 'n slide</li> <li>• Bring your own water slide inner-tube: save money</li> <li>• Rafting: Protective water foot-wear, no thongs</li> </ul>
<p><b>Prepare for Sunday Meetings</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Appropriate Sunday attire</li> <li>• White shirt and tie / Ordinance documentation</li> </ul>	<p><b>Please bring a <b>potluck</b> side dish or salad</b> to share for the Saturday evening meal. Main dish and dessert to be provided. There will be refrigeration available for sides dishes/salads.</p>
